



WILL IT FIT GUIDE

Now that you've chosen the style of your Neville Johnson sofa you'll want to make sure it fits - not only in your living space, but also through your front door. We've put together this useful guide to help. As each sofa is individually handcrafted to your specifications, the sizes quoted on our website may vary slightly.




RECORDING THE DIMENSIONS

Once you've clicked on your chosen sofa size, the dimensions will appear as depth, height and width. Make a note of these and measure up at home before you place an order. To make delivery as seamless as possible, many of our sofas have removable feet and arms. Plus, some of the larger styles, such as Hepworth, come in two parts.


MEASURING YOUR FRONT DOOR

With the front door open, measure from the outer edge of the door to the inner edge of the door frame. If this measurement is greater than your sofa's height, you should have no problem fitting it through the door. If it's smaller than this, measure the height of your door and check if this is taller than the height of your sofa unit. If so, our delivery team can carry the sofa through in an upright position.



MEASURING YOUR HALLWAY & INTERNAL DOORS

Even if your front door seems big enough, your internal doors may not be. You can check by measuring the width of your hallway at its narrowest point to see if it's wider than the height of your sofa. Simply follow the same procedure for internal doors.



WHAT ABOUT GOING UPSTAIRS?

If your new sofa is for a bedroom, don't forget to measure the width of your stairs at their narrowest point and see if it is wider than the height of your sofa. If the answer is yes, it should fit. You'll also need to measure the width, depth and height of your landing. If all of these measurements are bigger than the corresponding measurements of your sofa, you should be fine. Banisters and light fittings also need to be taken into consideration to make the delivery go without a hitch.
